

## Swansea University Bus Travel abertawe swansea **Feedback to Action**





- No 8, 8X or 10 services.
- Bus services run until 2330.
- No direct connection to the Railway Station.
- Price of annual bus pass for students £395.
- Night time travel by taxi only (cost £10 plus one way).
- Services 8, 8X and 10 created (Brand new buses purchased).
- £90 discount on previous annual bus pass with the introduction of the new City wide ticket.
- Savings of at least £20 on term tickets.
- Late night pilot bus service on number 8 serving HSV, Singleton and Bay Campuses - Wednesday, Thursday Friday and Saturday until 0230 - use it or lose it.
- Late Night bus 'Code of Conduct developed'; Abuse it and lose it communicated.
- Frequency of bus service increases to accommodate students.
- New Bus timetables including all sustainable travel info.
- 8X campus to campus service increased from hourly to half
- Additional frequency built into services 4. 8 and 10.
- Ftr bus with larger capacity brought in for service 8X to help with cap.
- 10 service running out of term time.
- Additional frequency on late night services.
- £3 after 0930 off-peak ticket 'pilot' offered to students to help with integration of students from Bay Campus to attend Society events.
- MTicketing introduced to Swansea starting with students.
- X10 to Cardiff free for Annual pass holders and £4.50 return fare for all other students.
- Early Bird offer introduced on Annual bus passes purchased before end of September via MTicket.
- 10 £3.50 Day tickets introduced for cyclists who only occasionally use the bus from My UNi Hub.
- Launched the My Uni Journey page which includes journey planners for HSV, Singleton, and Bay Campus.
- Early Bird offer continued keeping prices as low as 2016.
- 24 hour bus service 8 linking Hendrefoilan Student Village, Singleton, City Centre and Bay Campus.
- 24 hour bus service 4 linking Singleton, City Centre, Liberty Stadium, and Morriston Hospital A&E.
- 10 service frequency increased and later service until midnight, including Saturdays.
- Saturday service introduced on service 10.
- £3.50 all day ticket introduced for all students using the Unibus services which last all day until 0500.
- Double Deckers introduced to take care of capacity issues.
- Frequency across all services increased.
